Who are we?

SENAD Community deliver person centred support to enable people to live in their chosen community as independently as possible. We offer support services to individuals with a range of complex needs, working closely with the service user, their family, social workers and health professionals. Our bespoke support plans are developed to meet the unique needs of the individual and recognise that service users have their own hopes, dreams and aspirations. Our flexible and creative approach to care and support ensures we are successful in enabling people with the most complex needs to live more meaningful and fulfilled lives. We also ensure a continuity of care in line with the changing needs and goals of the service user.

We offer (but this is not limited to) one to one support for young people and adults who have:

- Rehabilitation/support needs following life changing injury (post-operative or brain injury).
- Learning disabilities, autistic spectrum disorders and challenging behaviour (including people within the criminal justice system)
- Communication difficulties
- Lack of social understanding
- Physical disabilities and/or sensory impairment
- Specialist health needs
- Mental health needs

Features of our service include:

- A team of regular Support Workers to help with different activities, from a few hours a week to 24/7 care
- Staff that are personality matched and who have similar interests
- Development of independent living skills
- The reassurance that if a Support Worker is ill or on holiday there is someone else familiar to provide support
- Transition support
- Support within educational settings
- Ethnic and culturally appropriate staff as required
- Our housing enablement service supports clients when transitioning into the community and looking for suitable housing

Our Support can be provided:

- In the home
- In school/college
- To access community based services and activities
- During a period of transition
- To enjoy a holiday or short break
- We can also help an individual to find a home suitable to meet their needs
