JOB TITLE: Cook
MAIN LOCATION: Alderwasley Hall School (Inc Sixth Form Centre)
RESPONSIBLE TO: Group Services Manager, Chef Manager
SUBORDINATES: None

MAIN RESPONSIBILITIES:

- To assist the Chef Manager to provide a quality meal service to Alderwasley Hall School - staff, residents and visitors.

KEY TASKS:

- To prepare and cook food for staff, residents and visitors, including the preparation of special meals and party foods.
- To respect special dietary needs for certain residents and staff.
- To assist with the distribution of meals to all houses.
- To follow site policies and procedures in relation to Environmental Health, Health & Safety and Food Handling.
- To ensure all crockery and cutlery are in a clean condition prior to and after use.
- To ensure that the kitchen and associated equipment is kept in a clean and hygienic condition.
- To maintain high standards of cleanliness and hygiene within the work environment.
- To be jointly responsible for the safeguarding of children and vulnerable adults in our care, it is a requirement of this role that you adhere to all relevant safeguarding policies and procedures.
- Work within the spirit and intentions of the Equal Opportunities and Equality & Diversity policies and procedures and report any concerns to your line manager immediately.
- To undertake any other duties reasonably expected of a Cook.
- To work overtime as required by the business or requested by your line manager – within reason.

You as an employee are required by The Health & Safety at Work Act 1974 to:

- Take reasonable care for the health and safety of yourself and others who may be affected by what you do or don't do;
- Cooperate with the Company to ensure compliance with the law;

And Under the Management of Health and Safety at Work Act 1999 you as an employee are required to:
