Overview:

2016/17 was a record breaking year for the school. There was national uncertainty in GCSE results this year due to the implementation of GCSE reforms, including a new grading system for English and Maths GCSEs.

Students this year, were graded on a 9-1 scale (9 being the highest) for GCSEs in English and Maths, whilst retaining the A*-G scale (A* being the highest) for all other GCSEs.
