

Our Curriculum Outcomes 2019 2020

Our Post 16 curriculum is mainly based on students building a portfolio for the ASDAN Personal Progress Diploma (1) or ASDANs Personal and Social Development Diploma (2).

Students in Key Stage 3 and 4 complete work using the EQUALS semi-formal schemes of work to prepare for their ASDAN Programme at Year 12 onwards. There is no end of Key Stage 4 test/examinations as our students are working below GCSE framework levels; we typically measure progress and attainment using the MAPP framework (2) and Progression Levels (3) for comparison.
