Overview:


The results from the Summer 2021 examinations continue the rapid and sustained progress made in GCSE outcomes over the past few years. Whilst examination results are not the only outcome from the school they do provide an externally validated accreditation for the academic work of the school.

The Summer 2021 GCSE and A Level results were formed from TAGs (Teacher Assessed Grades) due to the Coronavirus Pandemic and the impact to schooling throughout the year. Our results were internally moderated by subject leaders and senior staff and also externally sampled by exam boards.




3 Year Rolling Averages

A greater measure of consistency can be gained by using 3 year rolling averages in order to flatten out year on year variation and therefore to establish clearer trends.
